- *We will accept any seeds, however we prefer those that are open-pollinated or heirloom, because seeds from these plants will be viable in the next year. If you do not know if your seeds are open-pollinated, please note that on this donation form.
- *Easy seeds to save include: tomatoes, beans and peas, cucumbers, melons and squash, annual and biennial herbs, lettuce, peppers, eggplant, spinach and miscellaneous greens
